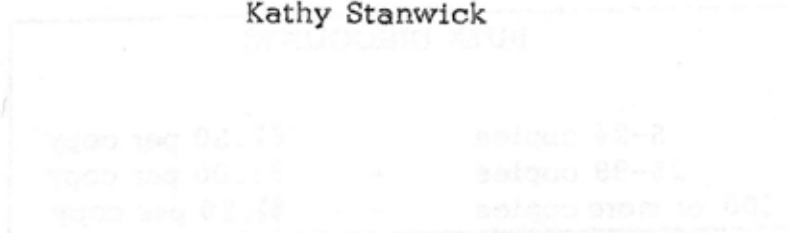

PREFACE

Voluntary Participation among Women in the United States: A Selected Bibliography, 1950-1976 provides access to information about the nature, extent, and political impact of U.S. women's voluntary activities and affiliations. This bibliography reflects CAWP's continuing efforts to develop and disseminate knowledge about women's public roles. The bibliography has emerged from the Center's focus on voluntary activity in its 1974-75 Florence Eagleton Grants Program.

The bibliography contains citations to published, unpublished, and ongoing work regarding the political, social, psychological, or economic character of the voluntary participation of women in the United States. We have included both theoretical analyses and reports of research. Studies concerning the ideology, motivations, and rewards of women's volunteerism are also included.

Relevant citations from the gerontology literature and from the literature on the socialization of adolescents are limited. Citations to the extensive literature on how to recruit, train, and retain volunteers have been excluded. As a rule, cross-cultural studies have also been excluded except for those which use the United States as a framework for analyses of women's volunteerism in other countries. Selection of the citations was based on content pertaining to U.S. women and voluntary participation. The selection in no way implies a qualitative judgment about any citation.

Materials cited include those produced between 1950 and June 1976. Works in progress at the time the bibliography was compiled are also listed. Citations are arranged according to their format: bibliographies; directories and encyclopedias; periodicals; books, monographs, and reports; articles; dissertations and unpublished papers; research in progress. The citations are listed alphabetically by author or main entry within each category. An author index which includes listings for the names of co-authors is provided.

CAWP plans to update and expand the scope of this bibliography. We urge users to submit relevant references to additional works. We wish to thank the many individuals who informed us of their own work and that of their colleagues.

CAWP's specialized collection of materials on women and United States politics contains many items listed in the bibliography. Inquiries are invited regarding these materials. Please contact Kathy Stanwick, Research and Information Associate, CAWP.
